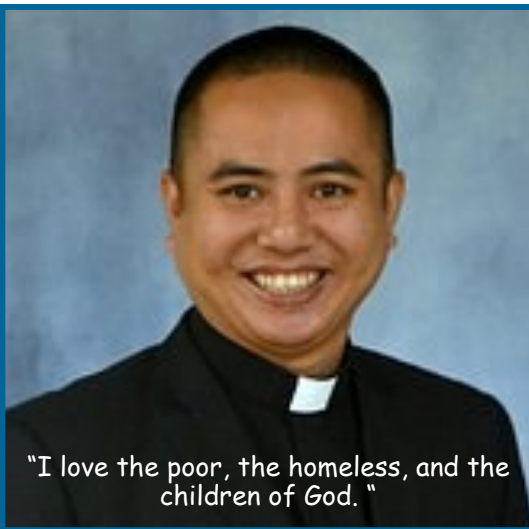

Throughout his life, Fr. Huan motivated young people in his parishes, helping them to discern vocations to priesthood and religious life. Now, because of the positive influence of Fr. Huan, there are many in my family who are priests and religious.
